



White Fang


The story starts when a female wolf gives birth to five cubs and all of them, except for one, die from hunger. A newborn cub is exploring the environment day by day, discovering cruel principals on how the world works. He gets into fights with squirrels, partridges and even a lynx.



The cub comes across a Native American, Grey Beaver. When a female wolf comes to a rescue of her cub, Grey Beaver recognizes her as Kiche, his dead brother's wolf. He takes Kiche and her cub and names the cub White Fang.



White Fang has a harsh life in the Indian camp: the current puppy pack, seeing him as a wolf, immediately attacks him. Indians save him, but the pups never accept him and chase him every time they see him. Grey Beaver is abusing the wolf and makes him aggressive. White Fang grows to become a savage, cold-blooded, harsh and deadly fighter, "the enemy of his kind".



When White Fang is five years old, he is taken to Fort Yukon so that Grey Beaver can trade with the gold-hunters. There, when Grey Beaver is drunk, White Fang is bought by an evil dog-fighter named Beauty Smith. White Fang, being a skilled fighter that he is, kills all of his opponents effortlessly. He is unbeatable, cold-blooded predator, until one day bulldog called Cherokee is brought in to fight him. White Fang is almost killed, when a rich, young gold hunter, Weedon Scott, rescues and buys him.

Scott tries to tame White Fang, and after a long time, he succeeds. White Fang experiences love for the first time in his life. Soft Scott's word, gentle Scott's pat is all White Fang needs to become a loving dog. A sparkle of love that was hidden deep in his cold heart creates a wildfire with Weedon Scott's efforts.
